# Woman hires Stewart & Stewart law firm to sue Muncie Mall. Think Smoothie over fall

A woman who says she was injured when she slipped and fell at the Muncie Mall has sued its corporate owner and one of its tenants.



In her Delaware Circuit Court 2 lawsuit, Gennie Bower reports she was walking through the mall, at 3501 N. Granville Ave., about 1 p.m. last June 10 when she slipped on a "foreign liquid" that was "just outside Think Smoothie," apparently then located in a kiosk in the mall.

The suit alleged Bower suffered "serious physical injuries, including, but not limited to, her right ankle," along with "physical pain, mental anguish and the loss of enjoyment of life." Her husband, Stephen, is also a plaintiff, saying he suffered "loss of consortium" as a result of his wife's injuries.

The mall owner, Simon Property Group of Indianapolis and Think Smoothie are accused of being "negligent in failing to warn (Bower) of the foreign liquid covering the hallway..."

The Bowers are represented by the Stewart & Stewart law firm of Carmel.
